I have a son, 29, in Brasil, who became hospitalized with motor-paralizes and who is begging for my presence. As you well know, a person cannot leave the U.S.A. during this period of naturalization.

Therefore, I come to ask for your help and influence in speeding up my case. I know that at election time the hearings do not take place, however, could you help me to be sworn in right after election?

I shall be forever grateful, as a resident of your district, for your help and consideration to my case.
